What is **OPEN LEARNING**

<u>Open Learning</u> is the university's all-in-one learning solution and a UMD-branded online catalog of non-credit continuing education opportunities. It is designed to serve current UMD students, faculty, and staff as well as members of the local and state community and beyond.

Platform features include a registration system, payment gateway, seamless integration with ELMS-Canvas, and automated Certificates of Completion.
